

### 3. NATURE OF HAZARD

A hazard is anything with the potential to cause harm. Examples of different types of hazards are: chemical, mechanical, environmental, ergonomic, electrical etc. Specify the type of hazard and identify what it is that creates the hazard. Ignore existing controls/measures & identify all significant hazards present.

Hazard	Hazard Type	Hazard source
1	Transmission	Customer touching exterior of door, handles and buzzer button
2	Transmission	Customer entering premises
3	Transmission	Customer's bicycle contaminated when dropped off
4	Transmission	Assessing/undertaking work on bicycle
5	Transmission	Handing over purchased stock to customer
6	Transmission	Taking payments from customer
7	Transmission	Staff proximity to each other
8	Transmission	Fitting unquarantined stock to bicycle
9	Transmission	Conveying information to customer
10	Transmission	Handing bike over to customer
